\* The above is a brief overview of the course schedule. Upon enrollment, you'll receive a packet that contains a more detailed course outline. In that packet, you'll receive dated park passes that will allow you to enter the Park at no charge on the days of the Workshop.

\* Participants must attend all sessions and turn in assigned work to receive credit for the course. The credit cannot be used for a degree at CSM, but may work for advancement in your district's salary schedule.

\* The course is limited to 15 participants. You are considered enrolled when your registration form and tuition have been received. Having you placed on a waiting list once we have 15 is an option.

\* Guided hikes will occur each day on easily managed trails. It is recommended that you have good walking shoes or light hiking boots. Sunscreen, hat and water bottle are also a good idea.

\* Bring a sack lunch.

\* State guidelines for Covid at the time of the Workshop would be followed. Any cancellation of the Workshop would be communicated immediately with a quick return of your tuition.
